International Walk to School day

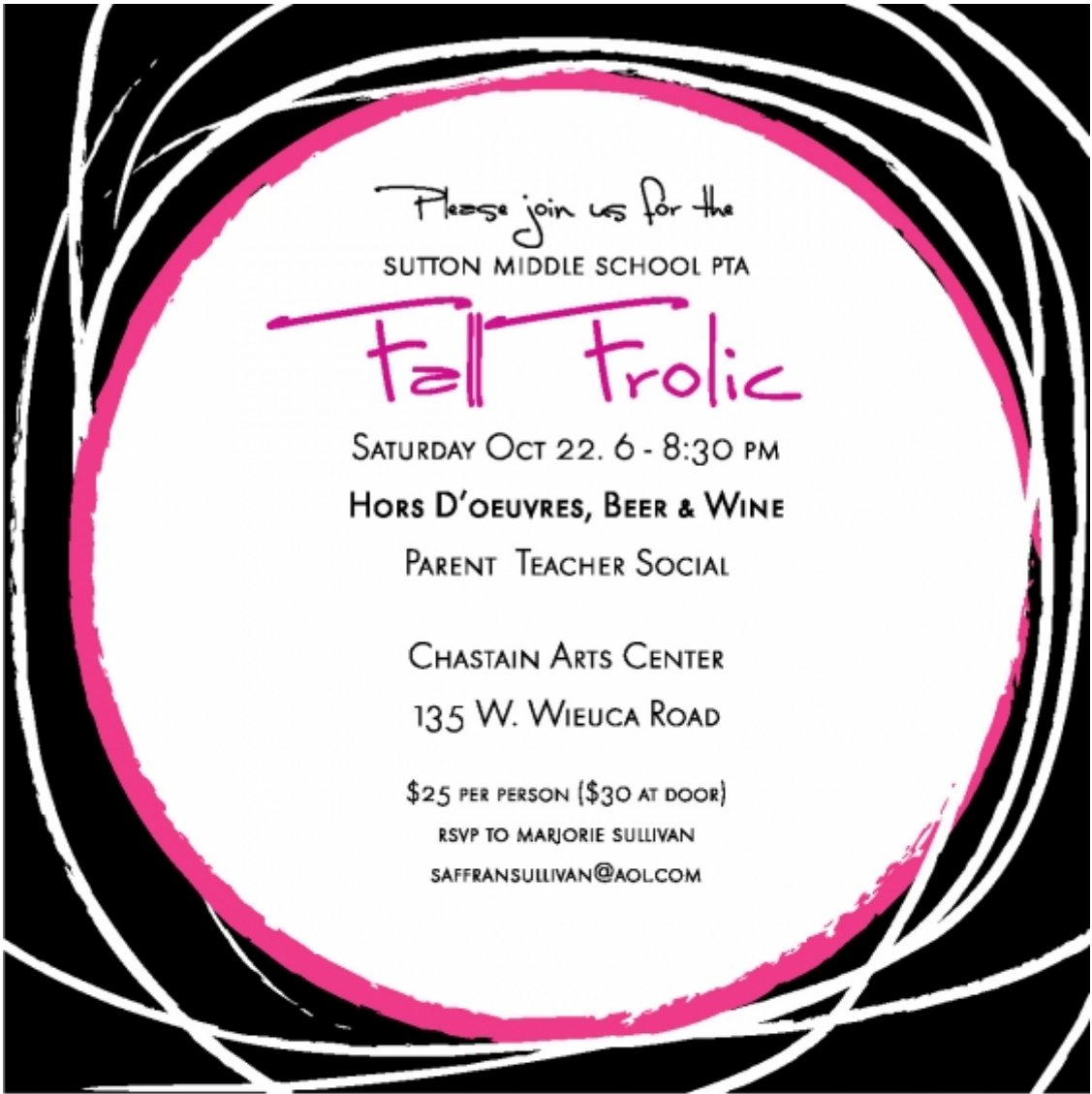
